



Dear Parents/Guardians:

All children entering Kindergarten in the State of Illinois are required to have the following:

- A Dental Examination by a dentist with completed Proof of Dental Examination Report
- A Professional Vision Examination by an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist is required with a completed Eye Examination Report
- A School Physical Examination with the following completed:
  - **PARENTS/GUARDIANS NEED TO COMPLETE AND SIGN THE HEALTH HISTORY ON THE BACK OF THE HEALTH EXAMINATION REPORT**
  - Diabetes screening
  - Up-To-Date immunizations

      - 4 doses of DTaP with the last dose received on or after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
      - 2 doses of MMR or 2 doses of measles, 2 dose mumps, and 2 dose rubella
      - 4 doses of polio with the last dose received on or after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
      - 2 doses varicella (Chicken Pox vaccination) or verification of disease by a health care provider
      - 3 doses of Hepatitis B

Any child who has not turned in a completed physical examination form by the first day of school in August may not be able to participate in gym. Completed examination forms should be brought to the school by the first day of school.

It is recommended that you keep a copy of your child's examinations at home for your records. If you do not have a copy, please request one from the school when you turn them in.
