Dear Parents/Guardians:

All children entering Kindergarten in the State of Illinois are required to have the following:

1. A Dental Examination by a dentist with completed Proof of Dental Examination Report
2. A Professional Vision Examination by an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist is required with a completed Eye Examination Report
3. A School Physical Examination with the following completed:
 - Diabetes screening
 - Up-To-Date immunizations
 - 4 doses of DTaP with the last dose received on or after the child's 4th birthday
 - 2 doses of MMR or 2 doses of measles, 2 dose mumps, and 2 dose rubella
 - 4 doses of polio with the last dose received on or after the child's 4th birthday
 - 2 doses varicella (Chicken Pox vaccination) or verification of disease
 - 3 doses of Hepatitis B
 - ***Parent/Guardian needs to complete and sign the health history on the back of the health examination report***

Appointments for physical examinations after October 15th are not acceptable in lieu of a physical exam for any students, except for those protected under homeless status. This includes students transferring from out of state; state law provides an extension for vaccinations for out of state transfer students; it does not also provide the same extension for the required health examination.

Any child who has not turned in a completed physical examination form by the first day of school in August may not be able to participate in physical education/gym. Completed examination forms should be brought to the school by the first day of school.

It is recommended that you keep a copy of your child's examinations at home for your records. If you do not have a copy, please request one from the school when you turn them in.
